Scrip

Scrip is a wonderful and easy way to raise funds for the school. New Horizon School - Los Angeles is now participating in this program. Scrip works the same way gift cards do. They literally are the retailers' gift certificates or gift cards and can be used in the same manner.



For every unit of scrip you buy, the school gets a certain percent of that value. Various retailers donate various percentages to the school. Scrip is available for virtually every commercial retailer-Vons, Ralphs, Arco, Albertsons, Mobile, Speedway Gas, Shell Gas, Old Navy, Toys-R-Us, Subway, Starbucks, Burger King, etcetera. For a complete list of retailers please see the Scrip binder in the office.

Scrip orders must be placed by Monday at 1pm and will be sent home with your child on Thursday of the same week. With a little planning, this is the easiest way to raise funds for the school. You will be, in essence, buying yourself gift cards to spend in the various stores you shop at, instead of using cash or credit cards. Orders are now being taken.
