L.A. County Fair Field Trip

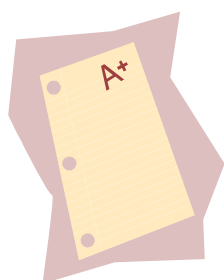

Test Taking Tips

As you help your children prepare for the fall midterm tests of the school year, keep these simple tips in mind, as they maybe the difference between an A and a B for your student.

- *Don't Cram* - In the week before the test, schedule several short study sessions.
- *Read the Directions* - Remind students to read the directions completely.
- *Skim the Test Quickly* - Encourage your student to skim the test quickly to understand what to expect and so they may answer any "easy" questions first.
- *Get Plenty of Rest* - Ensure your student gets plenty of rest before the test, so they may be able to focus on the test.

Scrip



One way of fulfilling parent service hours is by ordering scrip. Scrip is a wonderful and easy way to raise funds for the school. Scrip works the same way gift cards do. For every unit of scrip you buy, the school gets a certain percent of that value. For every \$200 dollars worth of scrip you buy, 2 parent service hours will be credited to your requirement. Scrip orders must be placed by Thursday at 1pm and will be sent home with your child on the Thursday of the following week.
